In Emercy's decision making process as to the recipients of this year's scholarships, Emercy International will make no decisions based on race, ethnicity, age, class, or other such characteristics. In order to determine the most eligible applicants for these scholarships, Emercy will focus heavily on the student's desire for future involvement in missions, as well as an indication of a strong personal walk with Christ. Other helpful factors will include your abilities to enter into the mission field in the year that follows the training school and your desire to pursue missions on a full time basis. These factors will not be the sole determining factor, and again, everyone with a desire to attend the school is eligible. However, If you have plans to attend the school and the financial means are available, please do not apply for a scholarship, as they are limited and this might prevent others truly in need from going.

Scholarship Details

The **William R. Glover Scholarship** is a full-paid scholarship provided by Emery International in honor of the Rev. Glover, who served over 50 years of his life in ministry and in missions. This scholarship covers all of the costs (\$550) of the training school and tuition, from the point of San Jose, Costa Rica. The student who receives this scholarship will still be responsible for airfare or whatever means necessary to arrive in San Jose.

Emery International will also be providing another scholarship that covers 50% of the schools tuition and other associated costs, leaving the student responsible for \$137.50 per month (\$275 total) and all airfare or other travel related expenses. Again, the student will be responsible for paying \$275 plus airfare, while Emery International will pay for the rest.
